

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

TAX IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (Codice Fiscale, mandatory for all students)

Incoming students must have a TAX IDENTIFICATION NUMBER that it is necessary to open a bank account, have a phone card, sign a rental contract for accommodation etc.

To finalize the registration at IULM, students must have a COPY of the Fiscal Code.

How to apply:

- Students can require their tax identification number to the consular authorities in their country of residence. As an alternative it is possible to apply to any Revenue Agency (http://www1.agenziaentrate.gov.it/english/individuals/tax_identification_nr.htm), by submitting a request form with a valid identification document and an entry visa for students coming from NON-EU countries.

ENTRY VISA AND PERMIT OF STAY (only for non-EU students)

Students who are not EU citizens must request an entry visa to the Italian Embassy or Consulate in their home country.

Handling all the papers to get a visa may take **about a month**, therefore we suggest you to apply as soon as possible. We will send an invitation letter to all the students coming from a non-EU University. In order to issue this letter, we will need a copy of your passport, you can send it at: incoming@iulm.it

Within **8 days** from your arrival in Italy, you will have to apply for the **permit of stay** (*permesso di soggiorno per motivi di studio*) at an authorised Post Office. This document allows you to stay in Italy for more than 90 days for study purposes.

Residence permit for study reasons allows part-time work for a maximum of 20 weekly hours and a yearly limit of 1,040 hours. It can be renewed only if the entry visa has been issued for a study course of more than one year in length.

Permits of stay for study reasons cannot be used or renewed to attend a course different from the one for which the visa was issued.
