**6 – DETERMINATION OF UNIVERSITY TUITION AND FEES FOR ITALIAN STUDENTS OR FOREIGN STUDENTS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN THE 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> YEAR OF COURSES IN THE 2018/2019 ACADEMIC YEAR, AND WHOSE FAMILY RESIDES ABROAD WITH FOREIGN SOURCE INCOME AND ASSETS (TABLES E, F)**

If a student's family resides abroad with foreign source income and assets, there is a **flat tuition rate** that can be found in the tables below. This rate applies to **EU and non-EU international students** living outside Italy, or **students with Italian citizenship or dual citizenship** living outside Italy, and is relevant to full-time or part-time enrolment in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree course for the 2018/2019 academic year.

The total amounts indicated in the tables do not include a regional fee for the right to education, which is currently equal to € 140, and a revenue stamp that is currently equal to € 16.

Any late payments shall be subject to a **late fee**, equal to € 50 for payments lower than 3,000 euros, and equal to € 100 for any amounts over 3,000 euros. In addition, all administrative and university-related activities shall be frozen until late payments are received.

**MINISTERIAL DECREE N. 1455/2017: DEFINITION OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 3, PARAGRAPH 5 OF DCPM 9 APRIL 2001 (TABLES G, H)**

International students who enrolled in the 1<sup>st</sup> year or renewed their enrolment for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of undergraduate and postgraduate courses for the 2018/2019 academic year shall pay the lowest tuition rate (See Tables G and H) if the following applies: the student comes from a particularly poor country (as defined in Ministerial Decree n. 1455 of June 9th, 2017, issued by the Ministry of Education, University and Research in agreement with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs); and the student's economic status has been evaluated by the competent Italian diplomatic authorities in the student's country of origin, whereby it has been certified that the student does not belong to a high-income family of high social status.

The total amounts indicated in the tables do not include a regional fee for the right to education, which is currently equal to € 140, and a revenue stamp that is currently equal to € 16.

Any late payments shall be subject to a **late fee**, equal to € 50 for payments lower than 3,000 euros, and equal to € 100 for any amounts over 3,000 euros. In addition, all administrative and university-related activities shall be frozen until late payments are received.

**DETERMINATION OF TUITION RATE BASED ON ISEE**

In the event that an international student meets the above-mentioned criteria and is enrolled as a full-time student in an undergraduate or postgraduate degree programme, then he or she shall be eligible for one of **5 merit scholarships**, worth € 3,000 each. Scholarship candidates shall be ranked based on the results of completed courses, provided that said courses are specifically listed as part of the Faculty's curriculum and duly registered in the student's transcript by the second exam session for the 2018/2019 academic year. The completed courses must be equal to at least 40 credits (CFU). Any credits from exams or activities that took place prior to enrolment will not be considered valid towards the CFU count, even if they have been recognized and inserted in the student's transcript. If candidates have the same number of credits, then selection will be based on their weighted grade point average for successfully completed courses. The scholarship will be awarded as a lump sum in September of 2019 following the publication of the ranked list of candidates.

**AID FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS OR ITALIAN STUDENTS RESIDING ABROAD (AS DESCRIBED UNDER PARAGRAPH 6)**

To meet any accommodation requests on the part of students, **10 beds** shall be reserved in IULM University's Residence Halls at a special price of € 280.00/month. Of these 10 beds, 5 shall be reserved for students enrolled in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of an undergraduate degree programme during the 2018/2019 academic year, while the other 5 shall be reserved for students enrolled in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of a two-year masters degree programme during the 2018/2019 academic year (full-time courses only). Please send requests to [dirittoallostudio@iulm.it](mailto:dirittoallostudio@iulm.it) **by July 31st, 2018**. In the event that the number of requests is higher than the number of reserved beds, the university shall draw up and publish a list of candidates ranked by merit (i.e. the student's final overall grade/score from high school or undergraduate studies).

Furthermore, IULM University shall provide a 50% reduction in tuition and fees in the following cases:

- 50% reduction in tuition and fees for the first year of coursework during the 2018/2019 academic year. This reduction shall be provided to **10 students who are enrolled full-time in an undergraduate degree programme** for the 2018/2019 academic year. Eligible candidates must have graduated from a foreign high school during the 2017/2018 school year with a final grade of at least 80 out of 100 (calculated using the formula provided by the Ministry of Education, University and Research). Candidates must provide official international certification of the final grade on their high school diploma.
- 50% reduction in tuition and fees for the first year of coursework during the 2018/2019 academic year. This reduction shall be provided to **18 students who are enrolled full-time in a two-year masters degree programme** for the 2018/2019 academic year. Eligible candidates must have achieved an undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 (on the American grading scale of 1.0 to 4.0) during the 2017/2018 academic year at a foreign university. This GPA must be certified by the University of origin or by a third-party agency.
- Full tuition waiver for the first year of coursework for **2 students enrolled in the Master of Science in Hospitality and Tourism Management** for the 2018/2019 academic year. This full waiver will be awarded to the two students with the highest undergraduate GPA, which must have been achieved during the 2017/2018 academic year at a foreign university. Eligible candidates must have achieved an undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 (on the American grading scale of 1.0 to 4.0). This GPA must be certified by the University of origin or by a third-party agency.

Please note that all reductions will be applied automatically. In any case, students remain fully responsible for revenue stamp fees, the regional fee for the Right to Higher Education, and any late fees that may apply.

**INTERNATIONAL DUAL DEGREE PROGRAMME: MASTER OF SCIENCE IN HOSPITALITY AND TOURISM MANAGEMENT**

The Master of Science in *Hospitality and Tourism Management* is offered in partnership with the University of Central Florida and the Université Grenoble Alpes.

Students enrolled in the 2018/2019 academic year will attend the first year at IULM University, whereas the second year (2019/2020 academic year), will take place either at IULM University or at one of the two partner universities named above, based on the student's choice.

Tuition and fees for the second year of the programme in the 2018/2019 academic year will depend on the partner universities, as indicated below (Board of Directors Resolution of October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017):

- Université Grenoble Alpes: € 3,490,00;

- University of Central Florida: € 18,000.00 in addition to a \$ 50.00 application fee to be paid to UCF by mid-January 2019. There may also be additional fees for the production of necessary documents (official transcript to convert the student's coursework into a GPA, IELTS certificate, etc.). All second-year students will receive a \$ 10,000 scholarship, which will be awarded in two instalments provided that students still satisfy the merit requirements stipulated in the UCF Agreement.
